1.1 FIXED AUDIENCE SEATING

- A. ACCESS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES: All designs with fixed seating (classrooms, auditoria, athletic facilities, etc.) shall provide integrated, dispersed, and compliant accessible seating. Follow guidelines as outlined in Florida Building Code, Chapter 11 Accessibility Code for Building Construction (Section 11-4.32, 4.33). Refer to Appendix B, Access for Persons with Disabilities.
- B. ACCEPTABLE MANUFACTURERS:
 - 1. With Folding Tablet Arms: American Seating, KI, Clarin
 - 2. Without Folding Tablet Arms: American Seating, KI, American Desk, Clarin
 - 3. Accessible Seating for Disabled Persons: American Seating (accessible products); GDS Seating (Flexible Access).
- C. NUMBERING: All fixed seating must be numbered. See "Section 10440 Interior Signage".
