Campus Master Plan Linda Dixon

Linda said that they were beginning the process of updating the Campus Master Plan and will be incorporating all the other plans that have been recently completed (Strategic Development Plan, Framework Plan, Housing Master Plan, and the Transportation and Parking Master Plan). She said that the Master Plan works much like a local government's comprehensive plan showing where and how growth is managed. She went over the schedule for the update and went over the Campus Development Agreement between the University and the City and County that is updated in conjunction with the Master Plan every (CDA) 5 years. She said that the CDA identifies the University's impacts on the City's

and County infrastructure and shows how the University intends to offset them, noting that the primary impacts are to transportation. She said that Campus Master Plan must be adopted by the Board of Trustees by December 30, 2020.
